

## 2024 FEES & LEVIES

St Joseph's Primary School set fees and levies each year and give careful consideration to the expected income and expenditure of the school together with the impact of rising costs on families. Fees and levies for 2024 are outlined below.

### FAMILY & CAPITAL / MAINTENANCE FEE

The Family Fee is tiered for 1, 2 and 3+ student families and the Capital/Maintenance Fee is per family.

### CURRICULUM & ICT LEVY

Income from the Curriculum & ICT Levy supports the purchasing of stationery, materials and resources for student use in the classroom and specialist classes, e.g. Art, Music, Library, Indonesian and Culture. It also assists the school to provide computers, tablets, information technology and associated support. The levy is higher for students in Year 5 & 6 as each student has access to a laptop computer for school and home use.

## **CAMP, SPORT, EXCURSION & OTHER LEVY**

Costs associated with School Camps, Excursions, Sporting Programs, visiting groups and performers etc... are financed by income received from the Camp, Sport, Excursion & Other Levy. Camps and excursions are an important part of the school curriculum, giving students the opportunity to experience learning outside the normal school environment. The levies for camps and excursions are carefully considered and budgeted for according to the number of students enrolled in each year level. It is expected that students participate in excursions and camps planned for their year level.

## **PAYMENT OPTIONS**

At the beginning of the school year, an account for the total school fees and levies payable for the current year is issued to families via email. A statement of account is then issued at the end of each month throughout the year. Families may choose to pay by the following options:

The school provides a number of options for payment.

Payment in Full: – Fees paid in full at the beginning of the school year.

Payment per Term: – Fees paid at the beginning of each term with the final payment due at the start of Term 4.

EFTPOS: – Payments can be made over the phone or at the office at any time using your debit or credit card.

Direct Debit: – Payments made weekly or fortnightly (Friday only), monthly (15<sup>th</sup> day of the month) from your nominated bank account.

## **PAYMENT OF SCHOOL FEES & LEVIES**
